Site and Competition Rules

Welcome to the inaugural IceInSpace AstroCamp! We hope you enjoy the opportunity to meet, socialise and observe with amateur astronomers of varying experience levels under the dark skies of Lostock.

This flyer lists some general site rules, as well as the rules for the Lucky Door Prize.

General Rules

- IceInSpace and the organisers of the AstroCamp accept no responsibility for the safety or security of your possessions while at the AstroCamp.
- Please supervise all young children, as there will be expensive telescope equipment that the owners won't want knocked over.
- When driving, be aware of local wildlife and drive slowly and carefully. The last 20km's into Lostock is narrow and winding and you never know what's around the corner. Please be careful and take your time, especially in the wet or dark.
- It is a condition of entry that you sign and hand in the <u>Acknowledgement and</u> Disclaimer form when you arrive.
- Do not drink the river water. Drinking water is available at the houses, but be aware it is tank water so don't waste it.
- You will be handed a name tag when you arrive. Please keep this on you or with you at all times it ensures you're a valid camp participant and it also serves as your "ticket" to the evening meal.
- Swimming is to be done in a responsible manner and children must be supervised.
- Please be all packed up and be ready to leave the camp by midday Sunday. We need to leave it how we found it, so please help clean up any mess you make and take your rubbish with you.

Competition Rules

- Everyone who has a paid booking (whether staying on-site or off-site) will receive a raffle ticket for the lucky door prize when they arrive. That is, **each person on your booking will receive a raffle ticket**.
- If you turn up on the day without making a booking, you can still be eligible for the draw if you pay when you arrive and sign the Acknowledgement and Disclaimer form.
- You are only eligible for the draw if you have signed and handed in the Acknowledgement and Disclaimer form.
- You (or your ticket) **must be present at the draw** to claim the prize. If the prize is not claimed within 2 minutes, a new ticket will be drawn.
- Gary Kopff from Wildcard Innovations will be drawing the tickets out of the hat.
- Each ticket that is drawn (in order) will get their choice of the (remaining) prizes on offer, until all prizes are won.
